

The Michigan Public Power Agency's Board of Commissioners meetings and some Project Committee meetings are conducted under the Open Meetings Act of the State of Michigan.

Meeting Attendance

Electronic notices of each Public Meeting are listed in the <u>Events Calendar</u> on the <u>MPPA</u> website. Each meeting notice will display whether the meeting will be held in-person or virtually. Members of the public are not required to register or otherwise provide information to attend, however, requirements for submitting comments and questions must be followed as indicated below.

To attend an in-person meeting, come to the location listed in the <u>Events Calendar</u> notice at the time indicated.

To attend a virtual meeting, click the link indicated in the <u>Events Calendar</u> notice. Audio instructions and options will appear once the meeting has loaded in your browser.

Public Participation

Members of the public, whether or not they are joining the public meeting, may submit written comments and questions regarding any matter, including items of business that will come before the Board of Commissioners (BOC) and/or Project Committee. Written comments and questions may be submitted at any time. Those submitted prior to the public comment portion of the agenda will be read aloud during the public comment section of the agenda. The BOC and/or Project Committee reserves the right to summarize long written comments and questions rather than reading them aloud but will provide Commissioners/Committee Members with the full text of these comments prior to the meeting.

To be considered for inclusion in the agenda or read aloud during the meeting, public comments and questions must include the full name and home address of the person submitting them and must not include language that would be considered vulgar or be interpreted as hate speech or fighting words. The comments and questions should also indicate the date of the public meeting for which they are being submitted.

Written comments and questions should be submitted to <u>this email address</u> no less than 5 business days prior to the scheduled public meeting to which they relate.

Americans with Disabilities Act Accommodations

MPPA will provide necessary, reasonable accommodations for those with disabilities who wish to attend a meeting after being provided notice in advance. Requests must be submitted in writing to this email address no less than two weeks prior to the meeting date.
